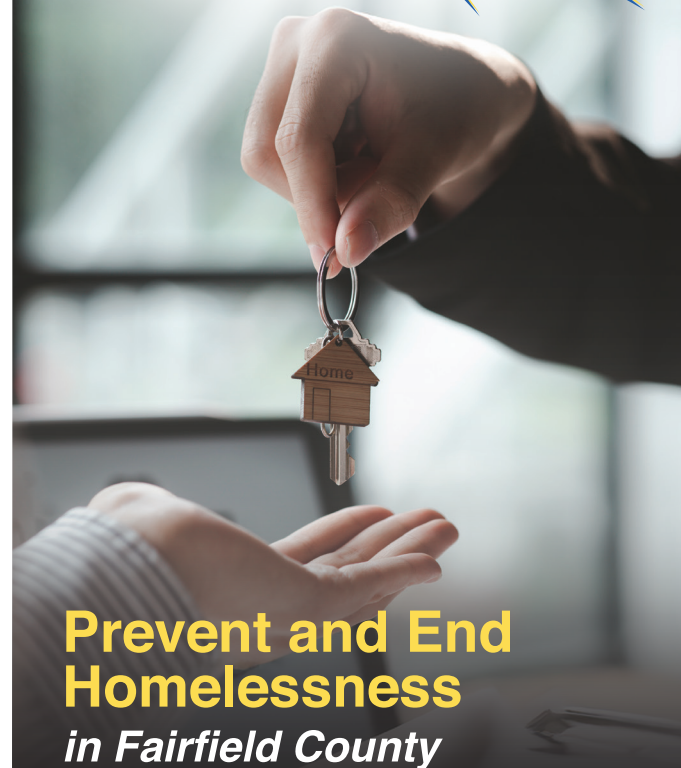

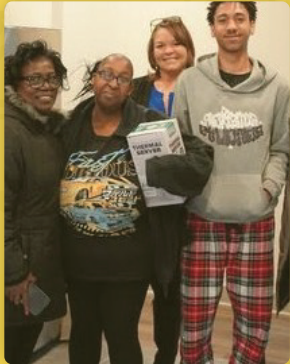

Who Pacific House Serves

Pacific House provides emergency shelter and permanent supportive housing for:

- Men and young adult males
- Women
- Families with children



What Pacific House Does

Outreach Services: Engages unsheltered individuals and families living on the street.

Diversion (Stamford HUB): Provides immediate help that facilitates connections to alternate housing options beyond the shelter.

Emergency Shelter (24/7): Offers a safe and welcoming space with beds, meals, showers, laundry, and on-site case management.

Permanent Supportive Housing: Pairs residents with supportive services that help individuals and families maintain housing and thrive.

Young Adult Services (18-24): Tailors programming with life-skills support, shelter diversion, and housing opportunities.

Supportive Services: Provides case management and connections to employment agencies, mental health services, substance abuse treatment centers, and additional services as needed.

Community Meal Program: Prepares and serves daily nutritious breakfast and dinner through our community-powered volunteers and partners.

How Housing Works

Pacific House intends to stabilize people who experience homelessness by securing permanent housing with supportive services provided once they are housed.

This approach increases housing stability, reduces use of emergency resources, and restores dignity.



Permanent Supportive Housing in Action

Pacific House develops and operates permanent supportive housing for men, women, and families with children in Stamford, Norwalk, and Darien.

The portfolio includes 15 homes that provide stable housing for more than 130 residents, which includes case management to support each individual's needs.
